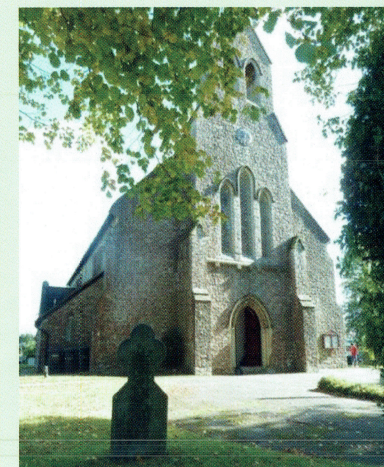

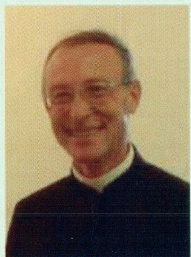

Your New Services

The new services contain messages and readings both religious and worldly, plus some good hymns to belt out. Below is a list the new rejuvenated services, why not come along to a service and stay for tea or coffee afterwards

From May 2014

1st Sunday 10am - All Age Family Service

A short informal service for all the family. Stories through activities, prayers, readings and hymns we know and love.

New to the church or feeling unsure, this is the service for you. (No Communion)

2nd Sunday 9:30 – Family Communion

Similar to Parish Communion but more relaxed and for all the family to enjoy together.

3rd Sunday 9:30 – Morning Prayer

A shorter traditional service containing hymns, readings and a sermon. - (No Communion)

4th Sunday 9:30 – Parish Communion

Traditional service with sermon, prayers, readings, hymns and Communion.

5th Sunday 9:30 – Parish Communion

(If applicable) – As 4th Sunday

During all services children are welcome to use the area at the back of the church

Early riser? – There is a shorter, traditional service at 8am every Sunday, prayers and communion, no hymns.
